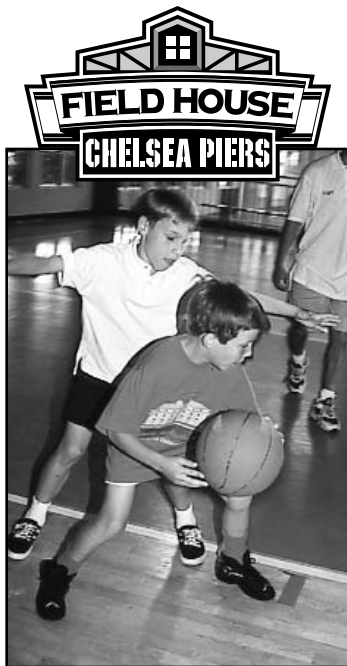

For the young athlete who enjoys a wide variety of sports, the Sports Academy at Chelsea Piers is a dream come true. Basketball, volleyball, soccer, baseball and European team handball headline the roster of sports offered at the Sports Academy, Manhattan's most exciting and comprehensive multi-sport camp. In addition to these popular sports, campers also have the opportunity to ice skate, bowl, rock climb and do gymnastics, all without ever leaving the city.

The goal of the Sports Academy is not only to offer young campers a place to play, but to teach them a wide range of skills which they will use for the rest of their lives. Through spirited play, geared to individual ability levels, campers develop competence, gain self-confidence and discover the fun of sports that match their talents and interests. At the Sports Academy, we firmly believe that confidence is the key to success and therefore, gear our teaching towards making campers feel good about sports and their own abilities.



CAMPER AGE RANGE

The Sports Academy is for girls and boys ages 6-12. Campers must turn 6 by the start of camp.

CURRICULUM

Age-appropriate curriculum is developed for each age group to maximize learning, safety and fun and to allow campers to achieve a high level of competency in all sports. Each day, campers learn and practice specific athletic skills and develop sportsmanship and team play through fun, spirited activities. Instructors promote social interaction and teach problem-solving skills on and off the field. Each afternoon, campers are given the opportunity to practice their newly acquired skills and to experience the thrill of competition during structured games.

RECREATIONAL PERIOD/ CROSS-TRAINING

In addition to their regular curriculum each day, campers have the unique opportunity to experience the many other sports available at Chelsea Piers. One or two days per week, campers may ice skate, rock climb, bowl and do gymnastics at the other world-class facilities throughout the complex. Chelsea Piers provides equipment for all recreational period activities.

ADDITIONAL CAMP HIGHLIGHTS*

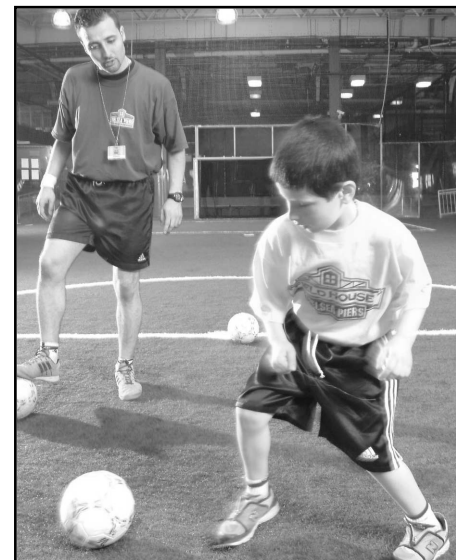
On special days throughout the summer, campers participate in a number of activities which are both fun and educational, including:

- **Harbor Cruises** aboard a Coast Guard-certified vessel once every two weeks, pending availability.
- **Professional athletes** who provide extra instruction and inspiration. Guest coaches have included members of the New York Yankees, the U.S. Olympic Team, the NY Jets, former NY Rangers and the NY/NJ MetroStars.

* All special activities are planned based on availability.

THE STAFF

Experienced, professional coaches lead daily training sessions in each sport. Mature and responsible college-aged counselors also provide supervision and support throughout the day. A low instructor-to-student ratio ensures personal attention for each camper and maximizes safety.



DAILY SCHEDULE (campers are grouped by age and ability)

Camp is in session Monday - Friday.

- 8:30AM Campers Arrive
- 8:45AM Camp Meeting (sports problems, puzzles, current events)
- 9:00AM Instructional Classes (basketball, soccer, volleyball, baseball and team handball)
- 11:45PM All Camp Lunch
- 12:30PM Recreational Period/Structured games
- 2:15PM Snack
- 2:30PM Structured games
- 4:00PM Campers Depart

Counselors provide supervision until 4:30PM. After 4:30PM, campers will be placed in After Care.

AFTER CARE (Takes place in Field House)

To allow parents a chance to complete their work day, Chelsea Piers offers an After Care Program from 4:30PM-6:00PM each day. After Care activities may include board games, videos, and arts and crafts. Parents may register for one day or up to five days per week. **Transportation is not available for campers in After Care.**

Cost = \$95/week or \$25/day

After 6:00pm you will be charged a \$20 late pick-up fee.

FACILITIES

The Sports Academy is based at the Field House, an 80,000-square-foot, multi-sport facility that contains two indoor playing fields (for soccer, baseball, European team handball, football and more), two hardwood basketball/volleyball courts, and four batting cages. Campers also have access to the other world-class facilities at Chelsea Piers.

DATES AND TUITION

The Sports Academy is divided into five, 2-week sessions and one 1-week session throughout the summer. For campers who enroll in multiple sessions, the curriculum is cumulative.

Sessions:

Two-week session = \$1080

Eight or more weeks = \$495 for each week enrolled

Each additional week after 2-week session = \$520

TRANSPORTATION

Selby Transportation will provide bus service to and from Chelsea Piers for an additional charge of \$95/week. Licensed school bus vans, fully-equipped with seat belts and two-way radio dispatch, will pick up and drop off campers at convenient corners within each major residential neighborhood in Manhattan and in parts of Brooklyn. **Please see the transportation application for detailed information.**

HOW TO GET TO CHELSEA PIERS

For those parents who choose not to use camp transportation, Chelsea Piers is easily accessible by car or by public transportation. Cars enter Chelsea Piers from 24th Street and the West Side Highway. On-site parking is available. Parents may park for free for 20 minutes while picking up and dropping off campers.

HOW TO REGISTER

To register for the Sports Academy, please complete the online registration or our camp application and the transportation application (optional) and return with payment, or visit www.chelseapiers.com/camp. Upon receipt of your application and payment, we will send you a Parent Handbook and invoice. Medical forms are due before the onset of your camp session.

MEALS

Chelsea Piers provides nourishing, well-balanced and generous lunches for all campers. The midday break is a time when campers relax, meet with friends and share experiences with children from other specialty camps.

The Chelsea Piers Sports Camp will host two Open House Days – Our Open House on March 3rd will be held at the Field House. Our 2nd Open House on May 5th will be held at Sky Rink.
